CALL TO ORDER: J. Hegarty called the meeting to order at 7:07 PM

APPROVAL OF AGENDA:

✓ J. Hegarty motioned to approve the agenda. Second by T. Singh. Ayes all present; the motion carried.

APPROVAL OF THE JULY 14, 2025 MEETING MINUTES:

CITIZEN / HOMEOWNER NON-AGENDA COMMENTS: None

OFFICERS' REPORTS

PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

- M. Waldbauer and J. Hegarty responded to emails about parking a boat. The boat has been removed. Per our Governing Documents: Recreational vehicles may be parked in the owner's driveway for a period not to exceed three (3) calendar days or any part thereof within a rolling 7-day period, but not on the street.
- Emma Kramer, Canton Township Resident Advocate, emailed about the next Neighborhood Know How, scheduled for Sept. 18. J. Hegarty plans to attend
- M. Waldbauer will update the PVHA website by removing the old by-laws.
- T. Singh contacted Bill Wagner, Ordinance Officer, about missing street trees. All of the street trees are missing at Lot #138, for example. B. Wagner can issue tickets for missing street trees—there are currently four (4) houses with missing curb trees.

- The U-Haul containers that were at Lot 25 are now gone. There has been a lot of activity and work going on at this residence.
- J. Hegarty asked if anyone responded to a Facebook group post from Bryan Amann about crab grass in Cul-de-Sac #1. K. Whitaker spoke to Oakley Lawn Service about crab grass control there and will also respond to B. Amann.
- There have been complaints about unsightly conditions at Lot #110. T. Singh will send a letter to the homeowners.
 - ✓ K. Whitaker motioned to approve the President's Report. Second by T. Singh. Ayes all present; the motion carried.

VICE PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

- In addition to what was mentioned in the President's Report, T. Singh will also send a letter to the homeowners at Lot 119 about a tree limb which has been lying in the grass for quite some time.
 - ✓ J. Hegarty motioned to approve the Vice President's Report. Second by K. Borninski. Ayes all present; the motion carried.

SECRETARY'S REPORT:

- K. Borninski posted the meeting notice in the Facebook group and completed the minutes.
- K. Borninski spoke with David Norwood, Canton Township Director of Municipal Services, about a drainage issue at the Windridge Entrance, which started after the Beck Rd. resurfacing.
 - ✓ K. Whitaker motioned to approve the Secretary's Report. Second by J. Hegarty. Ayes all present; the motion carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

- M. Waldbauer sent the Treasurer's Report via email.
- J. Hegarty asked about the \$25 charge—this was for the returned check from Lot 53. This homeowner is now current on the 2025 annual assessment.
- The \$5700+ check is the payment from the homeowner at Lot 141.
- K. Whitaker noticed that Oakley Lawn Service charged \$175 to remove the piles of large branches.
 - ✓ J. Hegarty motioned to approve the Treasurer's Report. Second by T. Singh. Ayes all present; the motion carried.

DIRECTOR and COMMITTEE REPORTS

ROADWAY MANAGER'S REPORT:

- No PRRMA update as the meeting is tomorrow.
- K. Whitaker will ask about the timing and prioritization of the sidewalk replacements at the PRRMA meeting.
- K. Whitaker did some tree trimming and landscape work on the berm. Thank you!
- K. Whitaker spoke with Al from Oakley about the wet area on Cul-de-Sac #3. It seems a sprinkler head is the issue so K. Whitaker and M. Waldbauer will investigate.
- K. Whitaker spoke to Zach Michels, Canton Township Associate Planner, about ordering trees. Zach quoted \$1500 for white pines to replace the trees removed from the berm.

- Seasonal Snow Removal sent a quote for service. K. Whitaker recommends moving forward with Seasonal. The quote was \$186 below the amount budgeted.
- There has not been any more unauthorized use of the irrigation system. M. Waldbauer installed locks on the controllers.
- David Nagy complained about a sidewalk trip hazard at Lot #117 with bees nesting underneath. His dog was stung and needed veterinary care.
- M. Waldbauer sent an email to Michael Sheppard, Canton Township Finance Department, about replacing bulbs in a streetlight.
- There is a large overgrown evergreen tree on PVHA property on the corner near Lot #1. The homeowner can trim the branches overhanging his property and K. Whitaker will check as well.
 - ✓ K. Whitaker moved to approve the payment of \$6200 to Seasonal Snow Removal for snow removal and salt applications for the winter 2025-26 season. Second by T. Singh. Ayes all present; the motion carried.
 - ✓ J. Hegarty moved to approve the Roadway Manager's Report. Second by K. Borninski. Ayes all present; the motion carried.

ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW COMMITTEE (ARC):

- A new veranda was approved for 1424 Crowndale Lane. Lot #156.
- A request to paint 45902 Overhill Lane, Lot #35, has been APPROVED by the PVHA Architectural Review Committee.
